

5. Strengthen our leadership and ambition at the international level

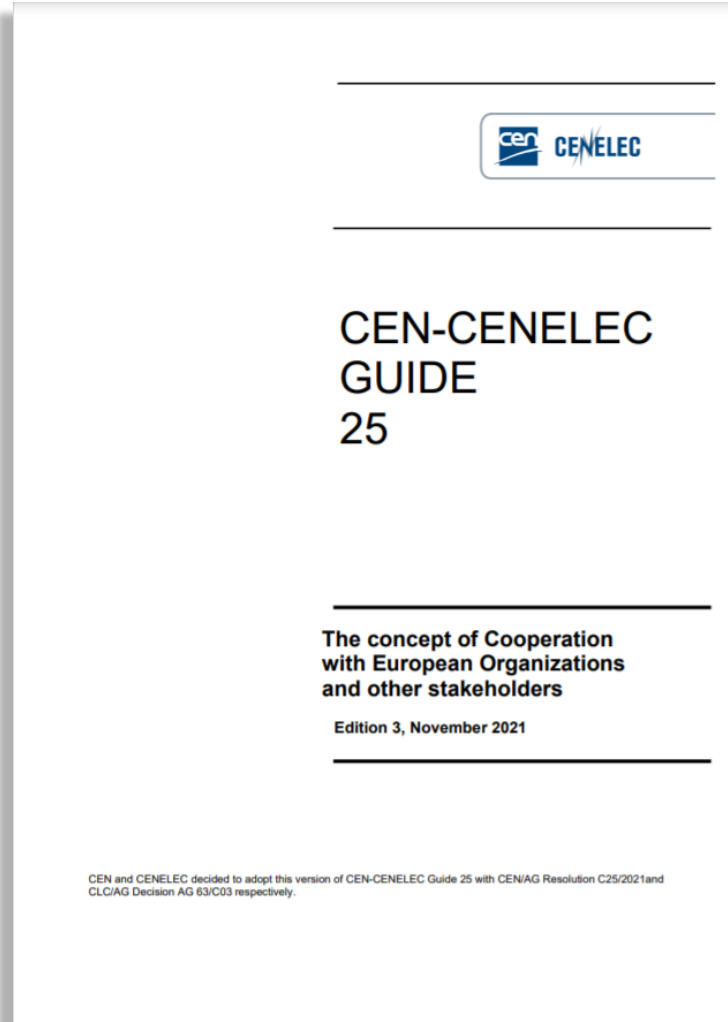

Revision 2021: What's New?

- 
- ▶ No impact on on-going cooperation agreements

Main changes:

- ▶ **Clarification of concept** : The 'Concept of Partnership' vs 'The Concept of Cooperation'
- ▶ **Alignment** of procedures and conditions to be aligned with revised internal rules
- ▶ **Clarification** of Category 6 criteria
- ▶ Revision for **Gender-inclusive** language
- ▶ Overall **health-check** and updated linked material

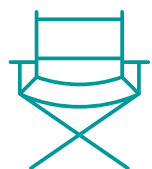
Category 6: Specification of who can fall under this category

"In few specific and exceptional cases when nature of the cooperation with the applying organization has been priorly assessed by CEN-CENELEC as not fulfilling the requirements of any of the above indicated categories, CEN and/or CENELEC may consider negotiating specific cooperation agreements on a case-by-case basis. Such specific cooperation agreements shall focus on an active cooperative relationship with reciprocal commitments between the organizations by means of mutual exchange of information on defined technical topics as well as strategic matters that are of common interest."

Category 1 - Partner organization

- ▶ Independent **European** or international European-based **(pan)sectoral organization**, able to represent a very significant part of the European interest groups related to its **defined area of competence** and to provide relevant inputs to CEN and/or CENELEC work

- ▶ **2 main areas of cooperation**



Participation in the **Governing bodies** and their working or advisory groups



Participation in **Technical Committees** and other technical bodies

- ✓ Access to working documents
- ✓ Participation in Technical Bodies upon TC approval
 - TCs: Observer ■ WGs: Expert
- ✓ No voting right
- ✓ Commenting at ENQ

Category 2 - Liaison organization

- ▶ Independent **European** or international European-based sectoral organization
- ▶ Cooperation between TC and **EU research project**
- ▶ Recognized expertise in innovative market segments

▶ 1 area of cooperation

Participation in **Technical Committees** and other technical bodies



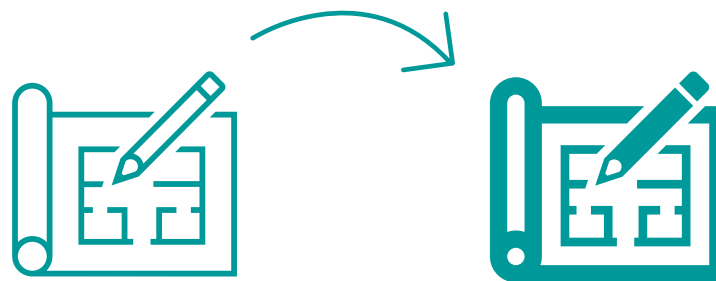
- ✓ Access to working documents
- ✓ Participation in Technical Bodies upon TC approval
 - TCs: Observer ■ WGs: Expert
- ✓ No voting right
- ✓ Inputs to the technical work (*Propose technical documents; Introduce preparatory work to support ongoing standardization activities; Submit technical contributions*)

Category 3 – Associated Body

- Identified European organizations having recognized technical expertise in a specific field, willing and able to provide **preparatory standardization work** on a systematic and organized basis to be **further introduced into the CEN or CENELEC standard-making process**.

Category 5 – European Institutional Stakeholders



- Relevant **European Commission's Agencies, Research Services** or other European intergovernmental organizations
- **Particular cooperation rights**

- ▶ In few **specific and exceptional cases** when the **nature** of the cooperation with the applying organization has been **priorly assessed** by CEN-CENELEC as not fulfilling the requirements of any of the above indicated categories, CEN and/or CENELEC may consider negotiating specific cooperation agreements on a **case-by-case basis**.
- ▶ Focus on an **active cooperative relationship with reciprocal commitments** between the organizations by means of mutual exchange of information on defined technical topics as well as strategic matters that are of common interest.



- ▶ **Particular cooperation** rights on an **ad-hoc basis**

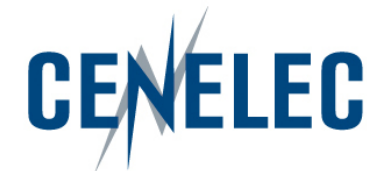
