Category 6: Specification of who can fall under this category

"In few specific and exceptional cases when nature of the cooperation with the applying organization has been priorly assessed by CEN-CENELEC as not fulfilling the requirements of any of the above indicated categories, CEN and/or CENELEC may consider negotiating specific cooperation agreements on a case-by-case. basis. Such specific cooperation agreements shall focus on an active cooperative relationship with reciprocal commitments between the organizations by means of mutual exchange of information on defined technical topics as well as strategic matters that are of common interest."




