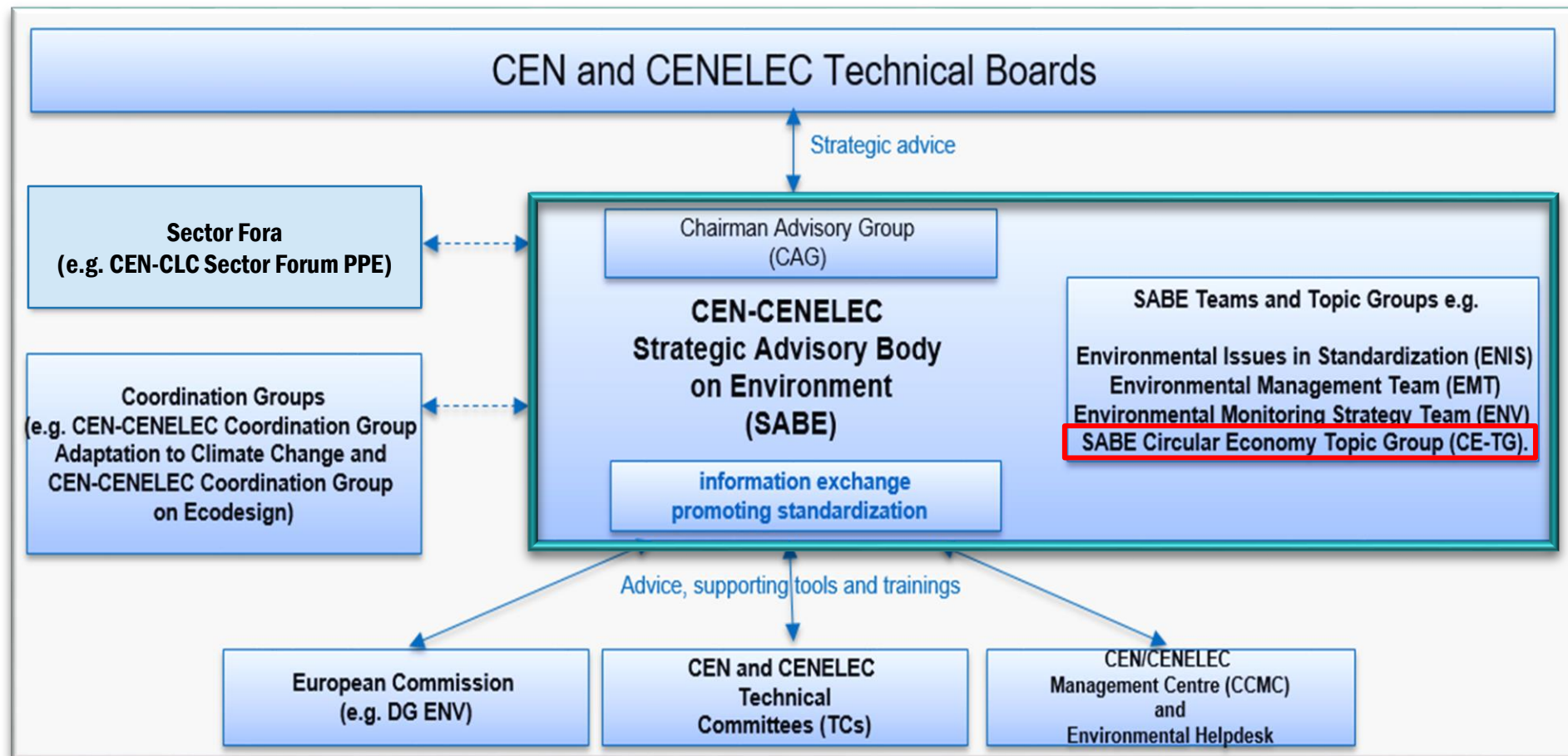

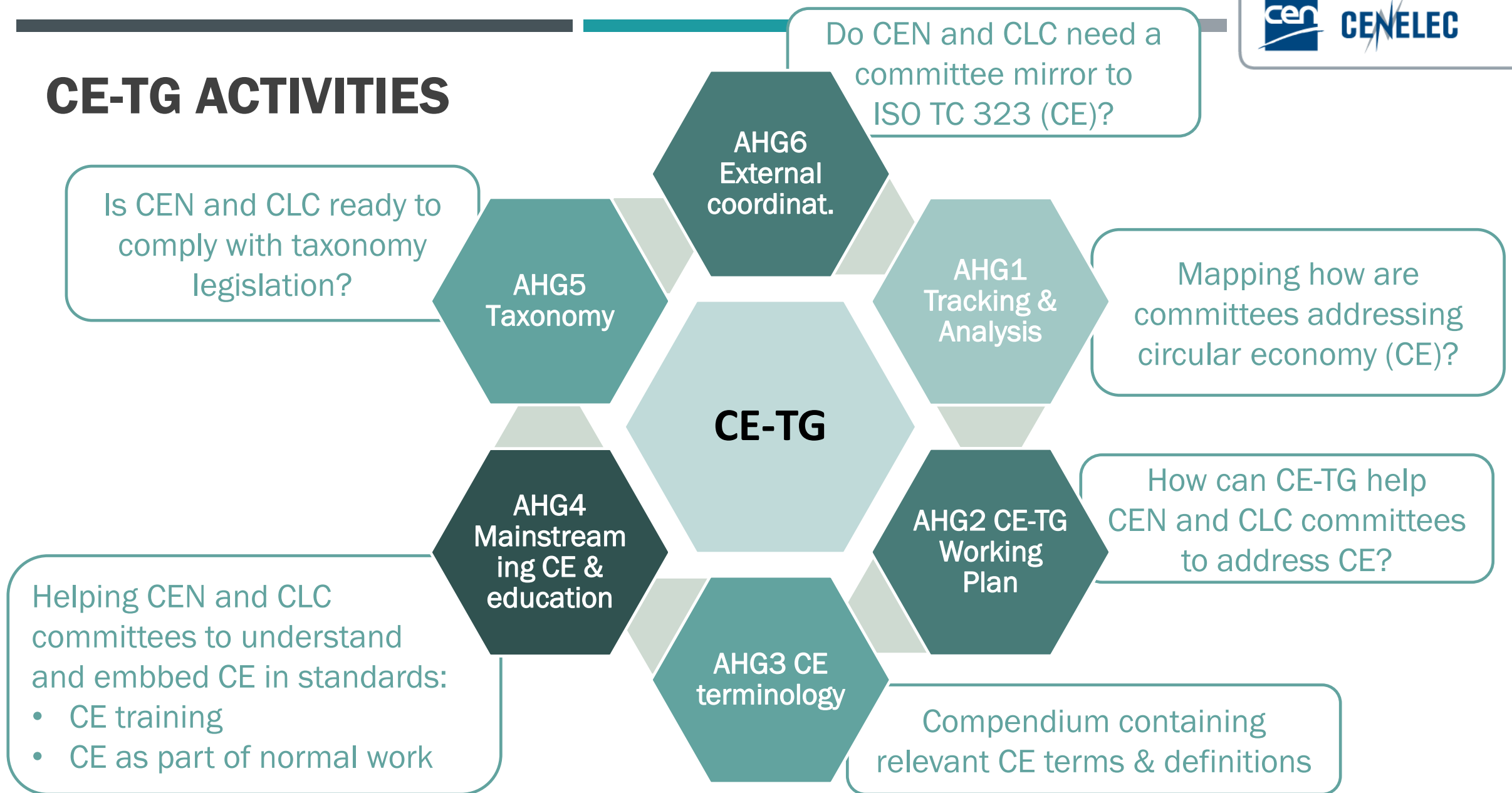
Highlights in Circular Economy standardization – 2nd event

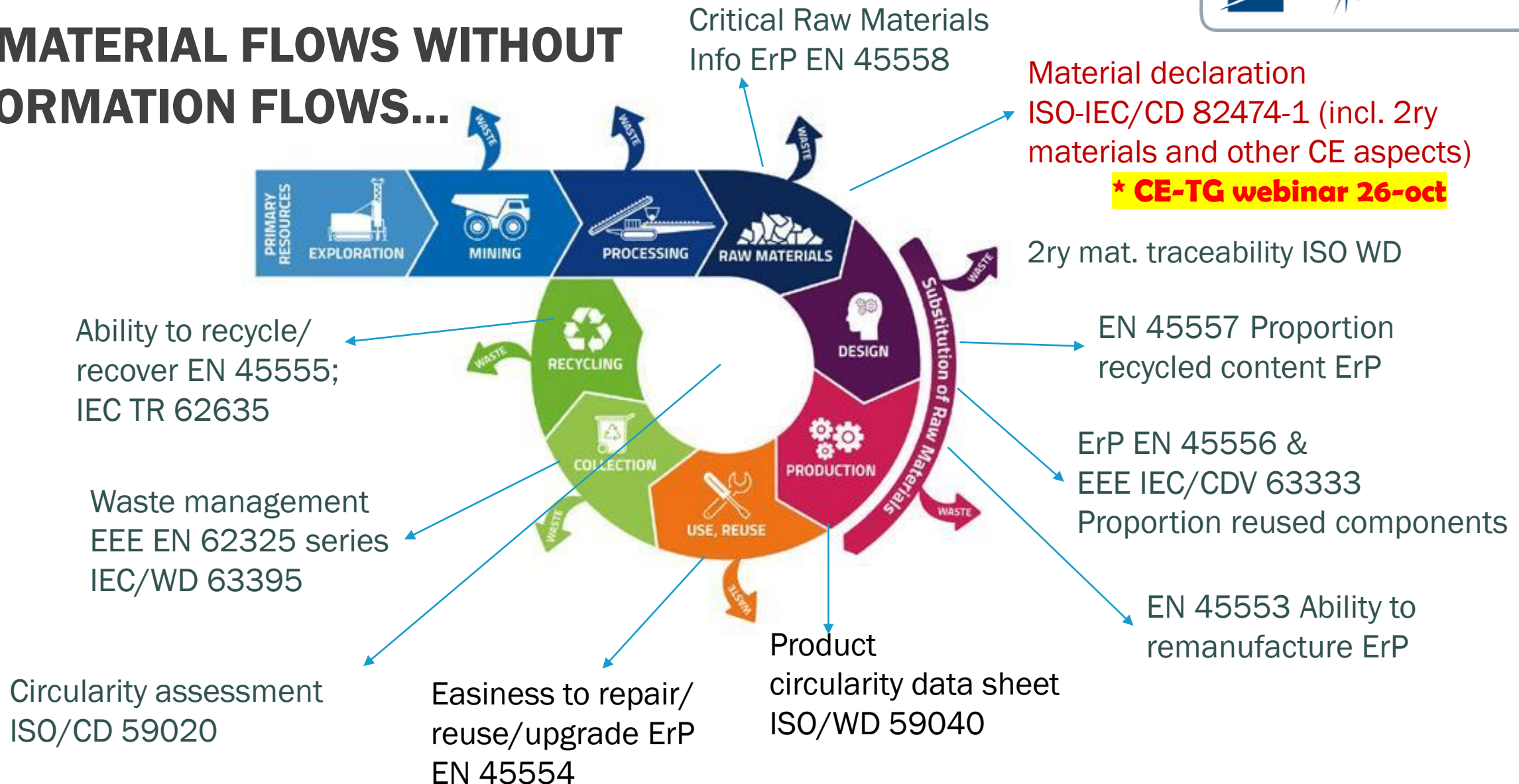

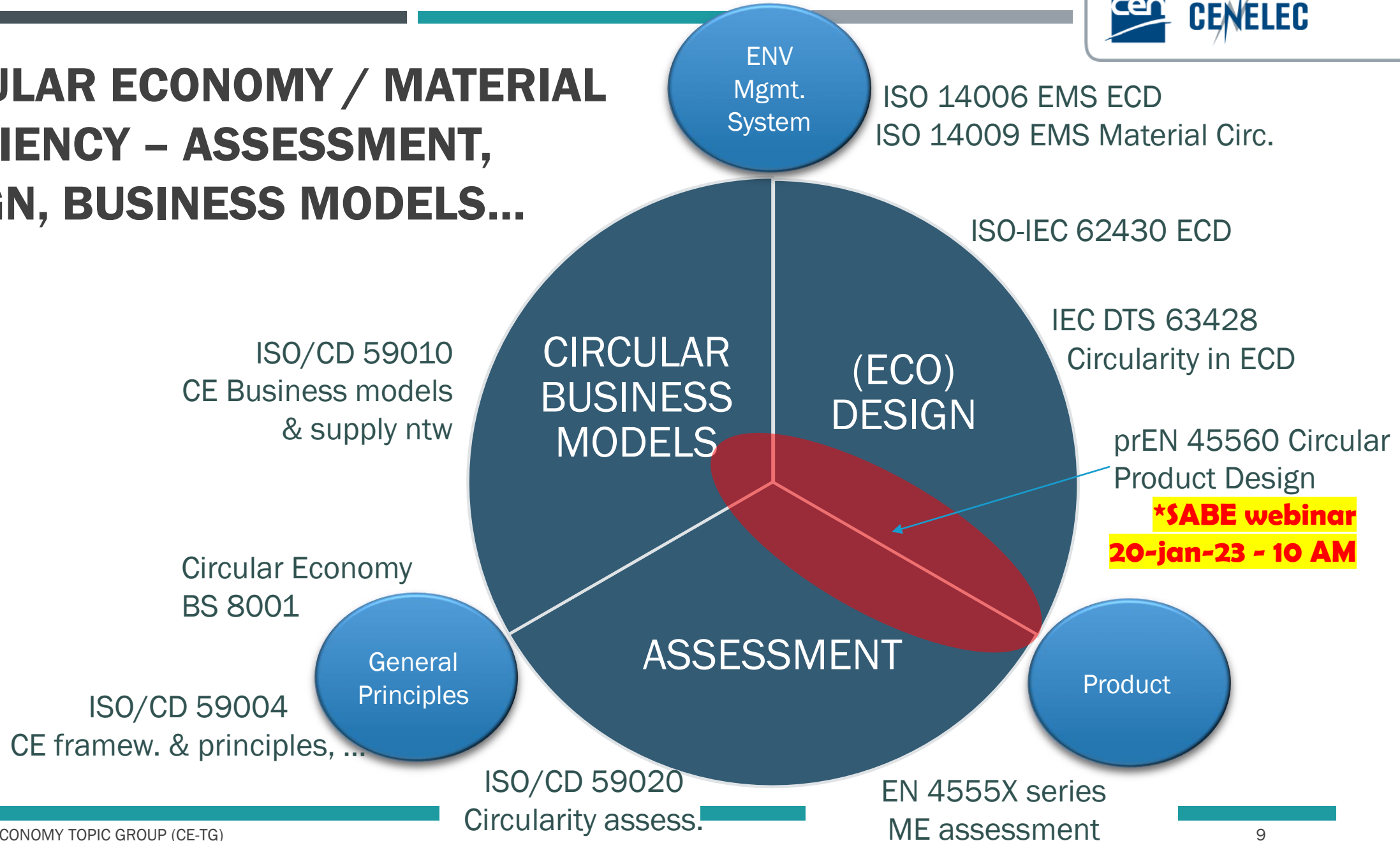
