ANEC

An Inclusive CEN and CENELEC System to be the preferred choice for standardization in Europe is one of the 5 goals identified in the CEN and CENELEC Strategy 2030

Participation of Societal Stakeholders and SMEs in European standardization, complementing their participation at national level -> Specific partnerships with CEN and CENELEC

 CEN-CENELEC commitment to inclusiveness reinforced by
EU Regulation 1025/2012 on European Standardization
EU Standardization Strategy (2022); High Level Forum; etc.





ANEC's mission



in cooperation with ANEC.



- Aims to represent and defend the European consumer interest in a <u>continuum</u> of consumer protection and welfare
 - the development and revision of European policies & laws related to standards, consumer protection & welfare (often in liaison with BEUC)
 - ✓ (key mission) of standardization (governance & technical levels of CEN, CENELEC & ETSI; sometimes technical level in ISO & IEC; UNECE, with CI)
 - the use of standards (conformity assessment, accreditation, market surveillance & enforcement)
- In 2023, ANEC <u>participated</u> in over 149 technical bodies of CEN, CENELEC & ETSI, and in over 25 technical bodies of ISO & IEC; ANEC attended 350 meetings and sent 332 sets of comments on draft ENs.


ANEC Activities & Priorities





ANEC

- ANEC is an independent, private and not-for-profit association (AISBL).
- Membership mirrors CEN-CENELEC (34 countries) with national consumer organizations in each country nominating a national representative to the ANEC General Assembly (31 countries).
- Relies on funding from the EU (95%) and EFTA (5%) for its core mission.

- Can comment at ENQ and during Formal Vote





The Opinion mechanism - Digitalized

→ See detailed process on <u>CEN BOSS</u> 1. SSOs submit Opinion on eBalloting platform (filled-in template) \rightarrow Submitted Opinion will be **visible** for all voters, including the TC/SC Chairperson and Secretary, while the ballot is open. 2.

- Upon closing of the ballot, the Opinion result table is integrated into the 'results page' (new dedicated table) + CCMC attaches the filled-in template to the 'Voting Results' file and uploads it on Projex-Online (CEN).
- The Opinion needs to be considered together with all the 3. comments submitted during Enquiry, or - if submitted at FV during the first occasion the TC/SC has, which will in most cases be its next meeting.

 \rightarrow The TC/SC decides on the follow up to be given to the **Opinion** (especially if not-favourable) and informs CCMC of decision.

→ Dedicated recorded **training** on the CEN digitalized process






The Opinion mechanism

- 1. SSOs \rightarrow CCMC
- 2. CCMC \rightarrow TC Secretary & Chair
- 3. TC Secretary uploads it on the CLC Collaboration Tool
- 4. TC Secretary informs the TC for consideration of the Opinion
 - > together with all submitted comments (ENQ)
 - > At first occasion, most likely next meeting (FV)
- **5. TC agrees** on the follow up \rightarrow CCMC


CENELEC CEN-CENELEC GUIDE 17 Guidance for writing standards taking into account micro, small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) needs Edition 1, June 2010 CEN and CENELEC decided to adopt this new CEN-CENELEC Guide 17 with CEN Technical Board Resolution C046 of 2010-06-04 and CENELEC Technical Board Resolution D137/C059 of 2010-06-01

- Guidance for standard-drafters on relevant issues to consider when drafting standards to ensure inclusion of SMEs in the market and avoid distortion of fair competition.
- ► The guide is relevant to all involved in WGs, TCs & national (mirror) committees → Checklist
- Tips on issues to consider during preparation of NWI, preparation and development of a standard, structure and presentation of content,...

The added-value of Inclusiveness







Fostering inclusive drafting processes & environments

- Remember the different rights & obligations of the different stakeholder categories
- Use the tools and processes at your disposal to ensure enhanced participation of all stakeholders
 - ✓ If an expert from an Annex III organization joins your TC, CCMC has to add them in the Global Directory in order to give access to documents (not `their NSB/NCs' as they do not belong to a country)
 - ✓ There are specific rights and obligations for Annex III organizations in the CEN-CLC IR2 and CEN-CLC Guide 25 and the Partnership Agreements
 - ✓ Opinion Mechanism: TC/SC Secretary have a role to play to ensure dissemination of the opinion in the CEN and CLC environments (see previous slides)
 - ✓ **Code of conduct** of experts
 - *Guidelines on 'New normal'* for effective virtual, hybrid or Face-to-Face meetings
- ► Actively seek for participation of diverse expertise and profiles → aim for balanced composition
- Ensure equal opportunities for participation: consensus building is made with everyone involved





Collaboration with Annex III Partners: not only technical





- Participation in the Governing bodies and their working or advisory groups (General Assemblies, Administrative Boards, Policy Groups, Technical Boards, International TFs,...)
- Dedicated contact points at CEN-CENELEC Management Centre
- 2 dedicated high-level groups: SME-WG + Societal Stakeholder Group (SSG)
- Joint Policy actions and messages
 - ✓ E-learning tool
 - ✓ Webinars & events
 - ✓ Communication campaigns (CEN-CENELEC Strategy 2030; World Standards Day; SME Week;...)
