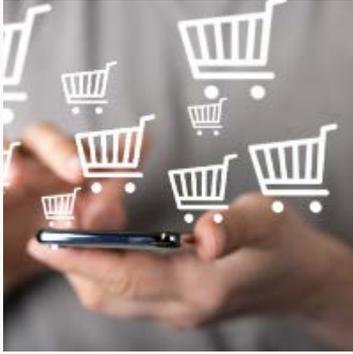


### PKN awarded the 2020 edition of the Standardization Compass
